



## **10 Things you need to know about The Drivers CPC**

### **Who does it affect?**

Anyone driving a commercial vehicle over 3.5t

### **When does it become law?**

September 10, 2009

### **What does it involve?**

35 hours authorised training before September 10, 2014.

### **Do I have to do all the training at once?**

No, the training can be split into 7 hours sessions and taken at any time before Sept. 2014.

### **Does the training involve a test which has to be passed?**

No, you just have to attend an authorised training session.

### **How is the training recorded?**

All training sessions are logged into a government computer for which you will have access to.

### **Can anyone do the training?**

No, the training centre and course must have approval by JAUPT (Joint Approvals Unit For Period Training) All training centres and courses will have an approval number issued by JAUPT which is a part of the DSA (Driving Standards Agency)

### **Can I drive a commercial vehicle after Sept. 2014, if I haven't done the training?**

No, a card will be issued like a driver's licence once you have accrued the 35 hours training and must be held at all times when driving.

### **Are there any exemptions?**

Yes, if you do not drive the vehicle for hire & reward you do not require a drivers CPC. e.g. Private horseboxes, moving your own home etc.
